Falco

Falco is a mid-early variety with a relatively long harvest period. High quality fruits with a long shelf life after harvest. Falco is a variety that thrives in covered and open field environments.

Cultivation

Falco is a large and well developed plant that guarantees good quality and a high yield. It blossoms a little later than the Elsanta variety. Falco thrives in tunnels and in the open field, with and without soil covering. Table-top system cultivation also leads to good results. Falco performs well in periods of high temperatures. The variety does not have any special fertilisation requirements. It is highly resistant to powdery mildew in field varieties, while regular protection is required in table-top system varieties. The variety is resistant to soil-borne diseases.

Harvest and retail

Falco fruits are large, uniform fruits with an average fruit weight of > 25 g. The first fruits often weigh more than 40 g and may have a slightly ribbed appearance. They are very juicy, while also having a long shelf life after harvest. The fruit has an intense red colour, is shiny and damage resistant. The fruit is suitable for both direct sales and retail. The fruit has a round, but at the same time, conical shape. Harvest is quick and easy. On average, five fruits are produced per truss. Falco is highly resistant to mildew and Rhizoctonia.
