Prius

- Very early, 4 to 5 days before Gijnlim and Cumulus
- High yields, of which large part in the first harvesting stage
- Good spear thickness, less uniform than Cumulus but 10% thicker than Gijnlim
- Firmly closed tips
- Suitable for cultivation in (mini) tunnels as well as with plastic mulch
- Resistant to rust, stable foliage
- Susceptible to fungal diseases



Vitalim

- Early variety, 4 to 5 days earlier than Gijnlim
- Suitable for growing in Central and Southern Europe
- High early yield, of which large part in the first harvesting stage
- Thick spears
- Firmly closed tips
- Spear quality can differ when the temperature changes
- Suitable for forcing methods under cover or in (mini) tunnels
- Stable long production life, vital grower



Gijnlim

- Early variety, the standard and reference for all other varieties
- Suitable for growing in Northern Europe
- High yields, also suitable for green asparagus
- · Good straight spear quality
- Excellent closed tips
- Suitable to grow under cover and in mini tunnels
- Ideal for farm gate sales Irrigate sufficiently during drought in the vegetative stage



Cumulus

- Early variety
- Suitable for growing in Northern Europe
- · Very nice white spears
- Excellent grades
- Good flavour, won several taste competitions
- Suitable to grow under cover or in mini tunnels
- Crop can be sensitive to wind and breakage
- Lower nitrogen requirements



Ramires

- Early variety, 1 to 2 days later than Gijnlim
- Suitable for growing in Northern, Central and Southern Europe
- Yield similar to Gijnlim, but with more uniform spear thickness
- Good flavour
- Suitable for cultivation under cover and forcing in mini tunnels
- Suitable for replanting
- Green and healthy foliage
- Long, profitable production life, disease resistant



Cygnus

- Medium early variety, slightly earlier than Herkolim
- Suitable for growing in Central and Northern Europe
- · High yields with uniform grades
- Firmly closed tips
- Suitable to grow under cover
- Very suitable for high plant densities
- Robust healthy foliage and low susceptibility to fungal diseases







Grolim

Medium early variety

- Suitable for growing in Northern and Central Europe
- High yields
- Firm spear thickness
- · Firmly closed tips
- · High yield performance
- · Suitable for forcing and extending
- Robust, disease-resistant foliage



Maxlim

- Medium early variety, suitable Central and Southern Europe
- · High yields, similar to Grolim
- Nice white asparagus
- Tip closure and spear quality similar to Grolim but with more uniform grades.
- Good flavour
- Less susceptible to hollow spears than Grolim
- Strong and stable foliage



Maralim

- Very tasty, mid-early, high-quality variety with perfectly closed tips
- 100% male hybrid, suitable for Northwest Europe
- High production potential;
 Very good quality grades
- Perfect tip closure, allowing harvesting rhythms to be adapted.
- Suitable for mini tunnels and open cultivation
- High resistance to breakage, hollowing, pink discolouration, and rust



Sirius

- MA 100% male, very white asparagus
- Late variety with high yield
- Thick stems with perfectly closed heads of excellent quality and good flavour
- Strong against rust, hollow stems and purple discolouration



Backlim

Backlim is a late and reliable variety

- Suitable for growing in Northern Europe
- Good uniform grades
- The standard variety in heated cultivation, early because of a good response to heat
- Quality increasing in the course of the years
- Very suitable for replanting
- Very robust variety with a long production life
- When overfertilised, higher risk of quality issues



Raffaello

- Medium late variety
- High yields, up to 20% higher than Backlim
- Firmly closed tips
- An excellent performer at higher temperatures
- Excellent spear thickness, quality similar to Grolim
- Long production life
- Suitable for extended cultivation
- Robust foliage and disease resistant
